

Introduction to map volume and errata sheet.

The following maps and associated tables have been developed from existing published information and available data. The maps are intended to be informative documents that provide an overview of the issue that they represent. The maps as they are reproduced here do not provide sufficient detail for on-ground use, planning or development. In the majority of cases, where map information is considered valuable for such purposes, greater detail relevant to the proposed action will be sought.

It is acknowledged that a number of maps have some minor faults. However, for the purposes of providing a visual over view of Northern Tasmania's natural resources and their condition, such errors are considered relatively minor and will be corrected in any future revisions of the strategy.

Errata

A number of minor errors or omissions have been identified since the printing of the maps and associated tables. These errors are listed below and will be addressed in the final publication of the accredited strategy.

- Map 4.** Legend “Bushcare management advice” should read “Bushcare management advice.”
- Map 4a.** Table. Delete “Wildcare Inc.” from 307.
Delete “Wildcare Inc.” from 90
Map 4a to become map 5 and map numbers to be adjusted accordingly.
- Map 5.** Table (will check *)
Column 2, para beginning “Plantation data.....” Delete single parenthesis from Forest Groups’.
- Map 11.** Table. Column 2 Paras commencing “NRM North has....” and “This prioritisation....” etc’s should read EVC’s.
- Map 14.** Legend “(MI)” should read “(ML)”
- Map 15.** Legend “Conservation areas” should read “Conserved areas”
- Map 17.** Column 2. Para beginning “The map.....” insert before sentence commencing “The table below” “The map is intended to show an overview of the distribution of dominant soils in the region. It provides an indication of the possible dominant soil identified within each land system only and the level of detail and reliability is inappropriate for planning.”
- Map 21.** To be deleted (and map number adjusted accordingly).
